**ORDER
GRANTING CONDITIONAL APPROVAL, PRESCRIBING NOTICE TO CLASS AND
SETTING FINAL HEARING ON SETTLEMENT WITH
GREAT WESTERN BANK**

NOW ON THIS __19th__ day of October, 2001, the court having been presented with the Parties Joint Motion for Conditional Approval of Settlement Agreement, and for approval of the Notice to Class Members, the court finds good cause to approve the settlement conditioned upon notice to the class and a final hearing on this matter.

THEREFORE it is ordered that the Settlement between Great Western Bank (“Great Western” and Tony Ross, et al, individually and on behalf of the class of members is hereby conditionally approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the class, as defined in the Joint Motion is conditionally approved for settlement purposes and the proposed class representatives and class counsel are appointed to represent the class in these proceedings for purposes of the Joint Motion and/or implementing the Settlement Agreement..

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any objections to the settlement must be filed no less than four days before the date set for hearing in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this matter shall come on for final hearing on the **9th** day of November, 2001, [**at 10:00 a.m.**] as set by the Clerk of Court, but no less than 20 days after notice has been made to the members, whereupon the court will consider any objections filed and will hear any objections or arguments by those present.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Notice provisions set out in Plaintiffs' Motion are approved. Plaintiffs' counsel shall cause notice to the members to be placed on the internet website of the National Association of Members in the form set out in Exhibit B of their motion, mail notice to the roster of members, or possible members, identified by Great Western, placing an ad in USA Today classifieds as proposed, as well as mailing notice to the approximately 1200 members who have registered with Plaintiff's counsel.
