**ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING OF SETTLEMENT WITH  
WESTERN AMERICAN NATIONAL BANK, CONDITIONALLY CERTIFYING CLASS  
AND PRESCRIBING NOTICE TO THE CLASS**

---

The Court, having been presented with the parties' Joint Motion for Conditional Approval of the Settlement, Conditional Certification of the Class, and Approval of Notice to Class ("Joint Motion"), and being fully advised in the premises, sustains the Joint Motion with Western American National Bank, now known as First National Bank Mid-Cities ("WANB"), conditionally certifies the Class of Members as defined in the Joint Motion, and prescribes notice to the Class, as set out herein.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Court conditionally approves the Class, as defined in the Proposed Stipulation for Release and Settlement for settlement and notice purposes (the "Class").

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED that the Court approves Tony Ross as Class representatives, and Douglas H. Napier as Class counsel.

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED that the Court approves the notice provisions, as provided in the Proposed Stipulation for Release and Settlement, and orders the Plaintiffs to cause notice to the Class in the form set out in Exhibit B of the Motion for conditional approval of settlement with WANB, conditional class certification, and approval of notice to the Class. In connection with the Notice, WANB is ORDERED to provide Class Counsel with the names and addresses of the Class Members, whose retail installment contracts were held by WANB.


IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED that any Class Member who desires to opt-out of this settlement must cause their notice of "opt-out" to be received in the office of Plaintiffs' counsel no later than ten (10) days before the initial date set for hearing.

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED that any objection to the proposed settlement shall be filed with this Court no less than ten (10) days prior to the hearing date, and a copy of the objection shall be served on counsel for the Plaintiffs and WANB.


IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED that a final hearing shall be set for June 8, 2006, at 1:00 P.M., CST, at the North Lee County Courthouse in Fort Madison, Iowa, -to consider final approval of the settlement and permanent certification of Class Members, and approving attorney fees and costs, and such other matters contained in the settlement or raised by objection.

In the event that there are no objections filed and the parties reach a resolution of any outstanding matters, the parties may contact the Court and waive the above scheduled final hearing by submitting a Joint Proposed Final Order, and the Court shall simply enter a final Order in this matter.
